Burnaby	1.522/m <sup>3</sup> for water, plus .66/m <sup>3</sup> to 1.2/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer, tiered.	Commercial
Abbotsford	Residential: 1.15/m <sup>3</sup> , plus .97/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer. Commercial & Institutional: Tiered, .15/m <sup>3</sup> to 1.15/m <sup>3</sup> for water, plus .78/m <sup>3</sup> to .97/m <sup>3</sup> tiered for sewer. Industrial & Agricultural: Tiered, .92/m <sup>3</sup> to 1.04/m <sup>3</sup> for water, plus .78/m <sup>3</sup> to .87/m <sup>3</sup> tiered for sewer.	Everyone
West Vancouver	Commercial: 1.10/m <sup>3</sup> for water, plus 1.65/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer. SF Residential: 1.30/m <sup>3</sup> (average of tiers) for water, plus 1.65/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer. MF Residential: 1.10/m <sup>3</sup> plus 1.65/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer. Note: Sewer is based on in winter consumption only.	Everyone
New Westminster	Tiered, from 1.31/m <sup>3</sup> to .568/m <sup>3</sup> for water, plus 2.36/m <sup>3</sup> to .4/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer.	MF Residential, Commercial
City of Langley (2013)	1.07/m <sup>3</sup> , plus .88/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer.	Everyone
Vancouver	Residential & Commercial: 1.06/m <sup>3</sup> for water (.842/m <sup>3</sup> Oct-May), plus .673/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer.	Everyone except Residential built before 2012
North Vancouver City	.9888/m <sup>3</sup> for water, plus .1077/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer.	Commercial
Delta	.85/m <sup>3</sup> up to 125 m <sup>3</sup> , then 1.18/m <sup>3</sup> above that, plus sewer charged at 80% of the water rate.	Commercial, and Residential built 2009 or later
Surrey	.8708/m <sup>3</sup> for water, plus .8688/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer (calculated as 80% of water consumption).	Commercial, and Residential built 1998 or later
Coquitlam	.787/m <sup>3</sup> for water, plus .6674/m <sup>3</sup> for sewer.	Commercial
